



Nominated film from Tralee Film-maker to be screened at CANNES

From the 14th to the 25th of May 2014, Irish Nominated Film 'Jacob Wrestling With The Angel' will be screening at different intervals throughout CANNES short film corner.

"Jacob Wrestling With The Angel is a story about an isolated artist who tenuously grapples with the inner demons plaguing his every waking hour. The resultant emotional carnage manifests itself through the incomplete canvas of his latest work as he begins a dangerous journey of self discovery guided by a beautiful young anima - Jennifer.

The sudden appearance of a mysterious Man further blurs the boundaries between memory and dream state as Jacob's world becomes consumed by an endless succession of nightmare metaphors - his obsession with a TV Interview; his masterpiece painting and mysterious pills that control the madness.

Jacob struggles through his dark night's journey into day as the mysterious Man and Jennifer guide him ultimately towards his own hidden truth - but at what cost?"

'Jacob Wrestling With The Angel' has had several screenings in Ireland already: in Dublin, Clones and Limerick Festivals, plus, the film was nominated for 'Best Cinematography' at Limerick Film Festival on April 12th 2014. The film has received rave reviews from several critics writing at Krank.ie, CineIreland and Scott's Movie Comments.
