The Cathaoirleach Cllr. J Moloney took the Chair.

16.05.26.01: 2016 Community Support Fund for Listowel Municipal District.

Ms. N O'Sullivan advised the members that there was a 50% increase in the number of applications for funding from the Community Support Fund this year. This demonstrates the positive impact that the availability of this funding is having on local communities.

She said that 480 applications were received county wide, 91 of these applications were received from the Listowel Municipal District.

Next year pre-application advice clinics will be put in place to assist groups interested in making an application for funding from the Community Support Fund in 2017.

She briefed the meeting on the following report which was circulated:

Cllr. L Purtill welcomed the Community Support Fund for 2016. He congratulated all involved in making the annual Listowel Writers Week a huge success and said that the " 12,000 allocation from the 2016 Community fund was very welcome.

On the PROPOSAL of Cllr. M Kennelly, SECONDED by Cllr. A Thornton it was agreed to approve the allocations from the 2016 Community Support Fund for the Municipal District of Listowel as outlined in the report circulated.

The meeting concluded at 11.25am.
