**1. Cllr. M Cahill:** That Kerry County Council give a detailed up to-date progress report on the Greenway between Glenbeigh and Cahersiveen and will the Council give favourable consideration to increasing compensation to land owners so as to ensure that this most important project proceeds.

**2. Cllr. D Quigg:** That this Council consider promoting Christmas Markets in South & West Kerry based on the German model that has become popular in other parts of the country.

**3. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Is any update available on the upgrading and improving of car parks on the Wild Atlantic Way?.

**4. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Has Kerry County Council received any reply from the NRA in relation to the traffic safety issues which have arisen on the new section of roadway on the N86 from Annascaul towards Gortabragoe?

**5. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That Kerry County Council look at the possibility of developing a walkway and cycle track from the suspension bridge in Kenmare out along the Castletownbere road. This area has been designated green belt and the landowners may well be amenable to such a proposal.

**1. Cllr. M Cahill:** That Kerry County Council address the housing crisis in the county by commencing a building programme as a matter of priority and will Kerry County Council confirm the land parcels in Council ownership with full planning permission and the number of units that are ready to commence, subject to the availability of funding.

**2. Cllr. M Cahill:** What progress has been made with regard to the acquisition of land for a burial ground in Beaufort as Churchtown burial ground is almost at full capacity.

**3. Cllr. D Quigg:** That this Council introduce measures that would see hefty fines imposed on those who continue to show total disregard for members of the public in relation to their dogs fouling in public places in South & West Kerry and implement a zero tolerance approach to it.

**4. Cllr. D Quigg:** That this Council endeavour to take another look at adopting a stricter approach to illegal dumping and commit to a long term plan of action to deal with this.

**5. Cllr. D Quigg:** That this council begin to take seriously the previous issues I have raised in relation to the upcoming 2016 commemorative events as the time for planning anything is running out.

**6. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Will Kerry County Council arrange to have the bottle banks returned to the outside of Feoghnach Hall at Baile na nGall?

**7. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would return the building in Castlegregory that was used to house the fire engines to the community as it was donated by the community first day

**8. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That we provide temporary public toilets at Cus Crann Beach, Over the Water in Cahersiveen particularly for the months of July and August. This is the preferred site for swimming and lifesaving courses in the area and is frequented

by hundreds of children and adults on a daily basis in the summer period. There are currently no facilities whatsoever and nearby private houses are turned into public rest rooms due to the lack of service provision at this scenic, safe and sheltered beach.

**9. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** Please allocate a house in Killorglin to (Details with Directorate) in light of her difficult circumstances.

**10. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** Please allocate a ground floor house to (Details with Directorate) in light of her medical condition and circumstances.

**11. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** That Kerry County Council please allocate a house to (Details with Directorate). They are approved housing applicants and in need of accommodation due to the difficult circumstances they find themselves in.

**12. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** That the South & West Municipal district lobbies the relevant departments for an increase in the allocation of housing grants to older persons and people with disabilities.

**13. Cllr. M O'Shea:** To ask Kerry County Council to provide social housing units for applicants in Lispole?.

**1. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council what progress has been made in coastal protection work in the South and West Kerry Municipal District?

What was the estimated cost of damage on this coastline?

What amount was applied for to the Government?

What monies were allocated?

How much has been spent up to date?

What action are the Council taking to complete work in the priority areas that need coastal defence?

**2. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council is there funding to install pedestrian footpaths from Brooklane restaurant to the main cross to Kenmare.

**3. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council is there funding to install pedestrian footpaths from Dungeagan Village to Cable O'Leary's.

**4. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council is there funding to install a safety barrier to run along the footpath between St. John's National School and Pobal Scoil Inbhear Sceine.

**5. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council is there funding to install extra lay-bys from Blackwater Bridge to Direendaraugh Chruch.

**6. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council to cut back hedges from Blackwater Bridge to Direendaraugh Church.

**7. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council to look into what the costs would be to take over the road from the Transfer Station to Gerah Cross on the Mart Road.

**8. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council is there funding available for surface dressing on the road at Maurice Fitzgerald's Public House to the beach in Castlegregory via the National School and GAA field. This road serves these important community facilities as well as access to the beach and is just off the Wild Atlantic Way.

**9. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council is there funding available for trunking and resurfacing parts of the road on the Moulnahone Road from the cross of Slievaduff back to the Blackwater Tavern?

**10. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council is there funding to install pedestrian lines on the road from Dromnevane to Lissyclerig.

**11. Cllr. M Cahill:** That Kerry County Council make a special case to the Office of Public Works (OPW) for funding for coastal protection works so as to ensure that family homes are protected from tidal flooding at Incharee and Cromane Lower.

**12. Cllr. M Cahill:** That Kerry County Council immediately extend the public lighting system adjacent to a section of Ireland's premier tourist route, The Ring of Kerry Road, from Glenbeigh Village out to Falvey's Caravan Park, as this section of road is extremely busy and serves a caravan park, a number of housing estates i.e. The Hideaways, Stoney River, Glen Castle, and Cois Abhann. This short section of Road is extremely dark and dangerous and is a major health and safety issue. I propose that Kerry County Council immediately request the Minister for Transport, Tourism and Sport, Mr. Leo Varadkar T.D., the NRA, the Road Safety Authority to immediately provide the required funding to address this urgent health and safety matter.

**13. Cllr. M Cahill:** That Kerry County Council request the NRA to surface dress Iveragh road from Bunkers roundabout in Killorglin out beyond JP O'Sullivan GAA ground.

**14. Cllr. M Cahill:** That Kerry County Council introduce a new traffic management plan in Killorglin so that the chronic traffic delays are addressed as a matter of urgency.

**15. Cllr. D Quigg:** That This Council attend to our minor roads in South and West Kerry, some of them are in terrible disrepair.

**16. Cllr. D Quigg:** That this Council introduce traffic calming measures to the estates in South and West Kerry (ie) ramps, this is the only system that will deal with excessive speed.

**17. Cllr. D Quigg:** That this Council agree to meet the Puck Fair Committee to discuss the insurance issues relating to the cattle fair in Langford Street and the clean up process that is conducted afterwards.

**18. Cllr. D Quigg:** That this Council put pressure on the sub contractors to finish the works to the N 70 that they started at Laharn Killorglin and also in Milltown Village in 2014.

**19. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Can Kerry County Council confirm if they are in a position to carry out improvement works on the road leading to the residence of (Details with Directorate) Ballyferriter Tralee?

**20. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** On foot of a reply from the NRA (NRA 14 -91309) will Kerry County Council forward a proposal to the NRA for funding to carry out safety improvement works on the N70 at Castlemaine.

**21. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Will Kerry County Council on foot of a reply from the Department of Expenditure and Reform apply for funding for coastal protection works at Kilshannig, Maharees, Castlegregory. The proposal should include substantial strengthening works and would require detailed planning and feasibility studies and technical analysis.

**22. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Will Kerry County Council clean the dykes and ensure that the lights are working on the Stradbally road leading to the Castlegregory golf course.

**23. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** On foot of an earlier request by me to Kerry County Council to ask the developer or the Management Company of the Fairfield Close estate at Upper Main St. Dingle to get the public lights working, will the Council again request that this matter is addressed.

**24. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Will Kerry County Council carry out additional widening and develop a car park with access to the sea on the road leading to Brandon village which is part of the route on the Wild Atlantic Way.

**25. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would erect a barrier on the Lauragh side at the top of Cariginine, as there is big drop off at this location and there was a serious accident there lately.

**26. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** Has Kerry County Council requested that the NRA erect a crash barrier on the bad turn at Gortnagillagh on the Bonone road where there has been serious accidents and loss of life in the past few years?.

**27. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would urgently repair the lag on the Bonone road at Carrignahillian, this in a ridiculous state and is damaging cars.

**28. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would repair the road at Araglin, Clohananoid, Castlegregory as this is used by several land owners and walkers.

**29. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would carry out a drainage programme in each area as roads are being washed away and undermined and a drainage programme would cost very little.

**30. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would line the road in Roosacroe from where the new road finished as far as the railway cottage as this is the only section without cats eyes.

**31. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would carry out traffic calming measures between the hall and the school in Lispole as parents have raised concern.

**32. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That Kerry County Council extend and upgrade the Pier at Rosdoochan, Sneem along its own lands in order to ensure the best possible health and safety of the fishermen and tourists who use the existing pier and with a view to upgraded facilities acting as a support to further develop the marine tourism potential of the area.

**33. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That Kerry County Council carry out much needed improvement and repair work along the road from Geokaun Mountain to Knightstown in Valentia. Approximately two and a half miles of the route requires work. This is a significant tourist route as is and with the designated Wild Atlantic Way (WAW) viewing and discovery points it will become an even busier route.



**34. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That Kerry County Council work with all relevant parties to rectify the dangerous junction at the corner of Woodbrook Estate Cahersiveen coming onto the Mart Road. There is an Eircom pole that needs to be moved as part of the process.

**35. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That the Parking/Viewing Site at Coomakiste be examined with a view to realigning the entry and exit markings as the current system is very dangerous. The area itself is at a very acute bend in the road and there are two points both being used as entry and exit s. The Tour Buses use this stop regularly and there have been many near misses and incidents there in the busier summer period.

**36. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That Kerry County Council work to replace the walls undermined by the work carried out along the New Line Road entering Waterville from the Cahersiveen side with appropriate fencing/ walls that would be as low maintenance as possible.

**37. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That Kerry County Council seek funding from the NRA to properly replace the retaining walls at Lower Waterville leading to Baslican/Caherdaniel. Part of this wall has given way and it will require significant funding to have the wall properly replaced. This is on the main Ring of Kerry road and we cannot afford to have the road impassable which will happen if the wall gives way entirely.

**38. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That we write to the OPW to ensure that they meet their obligations and cut the hedges along their lands bordering the roads leading to and from Derrynane House. This is a very busy route taken by thousands of tourists annually and it was a particularly dangerous route to drive due to the overgrowth along the road last year.

**39. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** Has the Operations Department made any progress in acquiring the small strip of ground between the Brooklane hotel and the junction at Gortamullen and a small strip of ground near Pairc Na Gloine at Gortmullen for the purposes of footpaths on the N70.

**40. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** Please give an update on what progress has been made in securing funding to improve the safety of the bridge at Kilkeana, Kenmare.

**41. Cllr. P Connor-Scarteen:** Please give an update on what will be done to accommodate traffic and locals when work on the N70 at Releagh, Bonane, Kenmare takes place.

**42. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** Please give an update on what is being done to rectify the drainage issues at the home of (Details with Directorate).

**43. Cllr. M O'Shea:** Ask Kerry County Council to erect 2 no. public lights at Lispole School and the Community Hall at Lispole. One at the junction of the N 86 and one between the hall and the junction

**44. Cllr. M O'Shea:** Ask Kerry County Council to provide funding for a footpath between Minard car park and the beach access as visitors are climbing through large rocks and stones.

**45. Cllr. M O'Shea:** Ask Kerry County Council to provide a general maintenance programme on all county roads to alleviate road surface water lodging and eroding roads surfaces

**46. Cllr. M O'Shea:** Ask Kerry County Council to cut hedges between (Details with Directorate) and Caragh Lake School where overgrowth of hedgerows is restricting sight lines?

**47. Cllr. M O'Shea:** Ask Kerry County Council to carry out a programme of surface dressing on the Muingaphuca spelling road adjacent to Caragh Lake?

**48. Cllr. M O'Shea:** Ask Kerry County Council to arrange for the replacement of the railing surrounding the Holy Well at Castlemaine as requested by the Tidy Towns Committee?

**49. Cllr. JF Flynn:** I propose That Kerry County Council resurface the road from Cromane national school up to the cross.

**50. Cllr. JF Flynn:** To tar the grass patch outside (Details with Directorate) in Kiltallagh Castlemaine as cars are parked there during mass and are getting stuck in the muck.

**51. Cllr. JF Flynn:** That a footpath be provided outside Cronin's shop in Castlemaine as there has been a few close incidents with pedestrians.

**52. Cllr. JF Flynn:** That the Knocknabulla road in Caragh lake be resurfaced.

**53. Cllr. JF Flynn:** That the footpath going out the Killarney road from Killorglin be continued out to Liebig as promised a number of years ago.

**54. Cllr. JF Flynn:** That a street light be erected in Iveragh Park, Killorglin down from the resource centre.

**55. Cllr. JF Flynn:** That Kerry County Council look at sorting out the lights at Knocklyne housing estate in Killorglin..

**56. Cllr. JF Flynn:** I propose that the bad bend on the Kiltallagh road be made safer, the ditch could be cut back a few feet and the road could be lined.

**57. Cllr. JF Flynn:** That the road at Muingaphuca East be resurfaced.

**58. Cllr. JF Flynn:** That a park be made available in Killorglin for tourist buses to park during the tourist season as it would bring a lot of business to the town if buses could stop

**1. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask the Kerry County Council when will white lines on the main Castletownbere Road from the Sailor's Bar to Killaha be done?

**2. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council when will the roundabouts in Kenmare be painted?

**3. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council who is responsible for filling potholes outside the wall of the Holy Cross Graveyard?

**4. Cllr. D Quigg:** Is it possible for this Council to do a long lasting job to the L11515 road at the Glen National School Ballinskelligs, where you turn off the main road onto a bye road ?

**5. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Is Kerry County Council ensuring that hedges are being cut along our public roads especially at locations where problems arose and complaints were made last year?

**6. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Has Kerry County Council earmarked funding in this years roads budget to improve the surfaces of the streets and the continuation of footpath improvements around the town of Dingle?

**7. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Is any update available on the 4<sup>th</sup> Phase of the inner relief road around Dingle town?

**8. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Will Kerry County Council advise on the Cois Cnoic estate at Cappagh, Dingle. What is the position with regard to the taking in charge of the estate by the Council and in the meantime can it be arranged to have the lights fixed?

**9. Cllr. S Fitzgerald:** Can Kerry County Council finalise the erection of public lighting from the Spa Road to Cois Cnoic housing estate in Cappagh which is to be funded by the development bond.

**10. Cllr. M Cahill:** That Kerry County Council and the NRA carry out immediate road safety improvement work at Tullig Upper cross Killorglin.

**11. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council when will a replacement sign be erected at Blackwater Tavern for Kenmare. This sign has gone missing?.

**12. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council would it be possible to erect a safety barrier on the first turn on the Moll's Gap to Sneem Road?.

**13. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council to give an update on funding for major lags on the Bonane road?.

**14. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council to cut back overhanging trees in Scarteen Park Estate?.

**15. Cllr. D McCarthy:** To ask Kerry County Council if there is any progress with the lighting in Castlecove?.

**16. Cllr. M Cahill:** Will Kerry County Council carry out urgent improvement works to the Caherciveen Community Resource Centre as a matter of urgency?

**17. Cllr. M Cahill:** Will Kerry County Council take in charge Knocklyne Housing Estate, Sunhill, Killorglin as a matter of priority? Planning Reference No: 95/633, 96/557, Take In Charge No: 14/02. Will the Council honour the letter dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2014 and will the Council ensure that no further fees be issued to the residents inclusive of Irish Water Fees.

**18. Cllr. M Cahill:** Will Kerry County Council request the OPW to provide emergency funding for coastal protection works to the Cliff Road, Rossbeigh, where due to recent slippages and undermining of the public road, 14 houses and a council housing unit are now at serious risk of being cut off?

**19. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would carry out repair works on the house of (Details with Directorate) as there is leaks in the roof and leaking on to fuse box this is unacceptable.

**20. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** (Details with Directorate) lives in a council house and the private road going to this is in a shocking state surely Kerry County Council is responsible to improve this.

**21. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would drain the Drombrane road as soon as possible as it is causing flooding to private lands.

**22. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would put back the plaque in Clononties Ballyferriter that was in remembrance of a Sullivan man this was taken away a couple of years ago when the road was widened.

**23. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would take over Dun Bui estate in Beaufort as this is an historic estate.

**24. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That Kerry County Council would extend the public lighting in Milltown to the speed limit on the Killarney side.

**25. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** I ask again that Kerry County Council would resurface the Dromoughty road as it is in a shocking state and the school bus driver is refusing to go up there.

**26. Cllr. J Healy Rae:** That a review of the traffic management plan in Killorglin would be looked at.

**27. Cllr. N Moriarty:** That lights be fitted at the Suspension Bridge in Kenmare.

**29. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** That Kerry County Council please ensure that the road from Kenmare to Sneem and onto the boundary of the Kenmare Engineer's area is salted when there is ice on the roads.

**30. Cllr. P Connor Scarteen:** Please arrange for the pot holes on the Rossmore road to be filled and ensure that it is upgraded when funding becomes available.
