1.Cllr M Cahill: That Kerry County Council carry out a feasibility study at an early date in regards to the provision of a Public Swimming Pool that would service the Killorglin, Mid Kerry, Cahersiveen and Iveragh area as this vast region has no such facility.

2.Cllr M O' Shea: That we the members of the Municipal District of South & West Kerry requests that the Municipal Manager would Liaise with the South Kerry Development Partnership (SKDP) in view of creating walks and cycle loops within the Mid Kerry area.

(b) Questions

1.Cllr M Cahill: Will Kerry County Council at the request of the members of the South & West Municipal area amend the County Development Plan so as to allow for the development of the South Kerry Greenway by allowing the route to deviate from the old Railway line where necessary, thus accommodating as many landowners as possible and ensuring that this vital project for the county becomes a reality and is completed on time?

2.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would hold one big information meeting on the Glenbeigh to Caherciveen Greenway in Caherciveen with all the stake holders, as a lot of land owners are waiting to hear back from Kerry County Council and are not sure on exactly what's happening.

1.Cllr M Cahill: That Kerry County Council provide Temporary Emergency Accommodation as a matter of priority in the Killorglin/Mid Kerry area, ie Hostel/B&B, as at present this type of accommodation is only provided in the 2 main towns, Tralee and Killarney, thus leaving a very significant part of our county totally unserved.

2.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: When will a review of Beach Infrastructure be carried out and can toilets be provided at Cuas Crom Beach, Caherciveen.

3.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: How many Council houses in the South & West Kerry Municipal District are lying vacant and what plans have Kerry County Council to repair them and give them out to tenants.

4.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please arrange for ~~no~~ cars+sign on Reenroe Beach, Caherciveen.

5.Cllr D McCarthy: To ask Kerry County Council is there funding to install public toilets in the Blackvalley. There is a large number of tourists moving through this area and there are no facilities from Kate Kearney's Cottage through the Gap.

6.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would buy houses in villages and towns where good value is still to be got especially where we have high demand, as it is now proving impossible to get properties for leasing.

7.Cllr J F Flynn: That we get a list of houses throughout the county that have been purchased since funding was provided earlier in the year

2.Cllr M Cahill: That Kerry County Council give a detailed explanation as to why it is taking so long for Boolteens village to get a sewerage scheme.

3.Cllr M Cahill: That Kerry County Council call on Irish Water to provide the necessary funding to replace the entire water mains network in Mid Kerry and also request confirmation in writing from Irish Water that all residents, farmers and businesses on the Mid-Kerry Regional Water Supply Scheme will receive a write-off of their water charges until such time as they receive a regular supply of good quality water.

4.Cllr M O' Shea: To ask Water Services to replace the old pipe that is supplying eight houses at Abbeylands Milltown. The old pipe is coming from Poulgorm Water Supply via the Abbeygate, it was promised that this pipe would be replaced some time back.

5. Cllr M O' Shea:To ask Kerry County Council to write to Irish Water as there is serious issues with water breaks between Brackhill Junction Castlemaine and Ballyraymeen where the old reservoir was one time. We ask Irish Water to make an application for funding to replace this old water pipe as it is there with over forty years and it is continuously bursting causing major disturbances to residents and farmers.

6.Cllr M O' Shea: To ask Kerry County Council to write to Irish Water asking them to honour the old agreement with eight farmers who have equal share and right with Goulane East Lake which supplies water to the parish and Lispole. The old agreements with Kerry County Council afforded these eight farmers with free water.

7.Cllr N Moriarty: That an issue with sewerage as indicated by odour and over flow at Iveragh Park be resolved fully.

8.Cllr J F Flynn: That we write to Irish water highlighting the number of bursts on the Tullig beg pipe line

(C) Questions

1/Cllr M Cahill: When will Glenbeigh village get a new sewerage scheme as the old scheme is at capacity for some time now?

2.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council investigate the sewage system in Kilgarvan regularly householders experience severe smell emanating from the waste water in the Village.

3.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: When will the work be carried out on replacing the water pipes on the Board of Works road, Beaufort.

1.Cllr M Cahill: That Kerry County Council protect a large number of homes/properties and the public road at Cromane Lower by raising and strengthening the sea wall as a matter of priority.

2.Cllr M Cahill: What plans have Kerry County Council to address the large number of estates that remain unfinished, where there is no current bond in place, where in some cases legal proceedings have been initiated, where the developer has vanished and whereby the residents have been left hang out to dry?

3.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would provide a power point at Kilmacologue pier as was previously there to help fishermen maintain their boats. They are quite willing to pay for usage by way of metre or whatever means.

4. Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would put up four ~~Deer~~+ signs, two on each side in Bonone, there has been six incidents in the last two months that locals know of.

5.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would carry out traffic calming measures at Kate Kearney's at the Gap of Dunloe, by providing two narrow footpaths at the bridge to slow down traffic or else speed ramps or something to help this dangerous situation.

6.Cllr S Fitzgerald: That Kerry County Council would urgently review roads safety measures at Ballyfinnane Crossroads. Including a full review of the junction ahead and ~~R~~epare to Stop+ safety signage, road linings and possible realignment or calming down measures as motorist travelling between Tralee and Killarney tend not to stop.

7.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please arrange for Go slow signage on the R569 in the vicinity of Rockmount Centre.

8.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please arrange for a Mirror to be installed at Reen Height junction on the N70 to assist people exiting lower Reen.

9.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please install road safety measures in Baile An Tooreen Housing Estate, Killorglin.

10.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please repair the Bridge at Drombane, Dromoughty.

11.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please examine and repair the wall in the vicinity of the Holy Well, Kilmacallogue, Lauragh, Kenmare.

12.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please arrange for adequate drainage on the N70 so that the two houses on the Sneem side of Tahilla Bridge no longer get flooded.

13.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please give an update on what progress has been made in the taking in charge of Cathair Lakes, Killorglin

14.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council to install safety barriers on both sides of the road beyond the concrete plant on The Mart road, Kenmare towards The transfer station.

15.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council to cut hedges at Sound Bridge to Barracks Cross in Tuosist. There are trees overhanging onto the road and are dangerous.

16.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council to cut hedges at Drombohilly. There are trees overhanging onto the road and are dangerous.

17.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council to cut hedges at Staigue Fort, Castlecove.

18.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council to install a ladder for the Pier in Sneem.

19.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council to draft up an estimate for cost of putting up a light at Sneem Community Centre to Sneem Church.

20.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council to clear drains at Toor, Emlaghmore, Ballinaskelligs.

21.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council to repair the road and open drains at Inny Tavern, Dromid, Waterville.

22.Cllr M O' Shea: Ask Kerry County Council to investigate the flooding at the entrance to Green acres Caravan Park as there is an issue with Drainage and flooding at side road entering Caravan Park at Green Acres.

23.Cllr M O' Shea:To ask the Director of Roads and Transport to write to the TII to seek funding to put in place a roundabout at Brackhill cross Castlemaine.

24.Cllr M O' Shea:To ask the Director of Roads and Transport to write to the TII to put in place a pedestrian crossing at Castlemaine Village.

25. Cllr M O' Shea: To ask the Director of Roads and Transport to put in place extra lighting out the Lyre road up by Ashborough Lodge and up by the private housing estates and also Tuairn Lin estate on the L4035.

26.Cllr M O' Shea: To ask the Housing Department to investigate the flooding problem at the property of (Details with Directorate) the back yard is water logged with water.

27. Cllr N Moriarty: That a sign indicating Killorglin to be erected at Beal Lá bridge cross in Dromod.

28.Cllr N Moriarty: That the overgrowth at the bridge near Curravacha be cleared as visibility is impossible for oncoming traffic from both sides at present.

29.Cllr N Moriarty: That signage stating %vehicular access for commercial fishermen only+to be erected at Kells Pier.

30.Cllr N Moriarty: That two trees at Langford street and Iveragh Park whose roots may be undermining the paths and nearby walls etc be removed. These trees pose a very serious health and safety hazard.

31.Cllr N Moriarty:That footpaths outside house numbers (Details with Directorate) be dishd to allow for wheelchair access.

32.Cllr N Moriarty:To have the footpath from St FiniansqTerrace extended to St Finians\$ NS to ensure safe passage for the pupils and parents of the school.

33.Cllr N Moriarty:To have the Dromeragh Road included in the next Roads Programme as this road is in a serious state of disrepair and has not been surfaced properly in a very long time.

34.Cllr N Moriarty:To have lay bys placed along the Garrouh Road in Caherdaniel.

35.Cllr F Flynn: That safety measures be erected at Battersfield on the Ballyhar road.

36.Cllr J F Flynn: That the Tralee road from Killorglin be resurfaced.

37.Cllr J F Flynn: That lights be erected along the footpath going into Glenbeigh by the old Glenbeigh Hotel.

38.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would install two extra lights on the Killarney road leaving Milltown so the lights would be then going as far as the speed limit

39.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would cut the trees in Deelis Park Beaufort which are completely blocking two street lights

40.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would replace gulleys that are consistently blocking with a number of years, one on the Dromoughty road and one on the Killaha road, Tuosist Kenmare.

41.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would now take over Dun Bui Estate Beaufort as the legal case sighted previously now appears to have no bearing on the legality of take over.

42.Cllr J Healy-Rae: That Kerry County Council would put up ~~Deer~~+signage on the Tuosist road.

1.Cllr M Cahill: Will Kerry County Council provide a Public Light immediately outside St.James Church, Killorglin as a matter of priority?

2.Cllr M Cahill: Will Kerry County Council give a detailed up to date progress report in respect to the acquisition of lands for the proposed new road that will by pass the dangerous Kilderry bends, when is it anticipated that work will commence and approximately how much will the works cost.

3. Cllr M Cahill:Will Kerry County Council commence a programme of resurfacing the roads in Iveragh Park, Killorglin, carry out repairs to the footpaths and make them wheelchair friendly, check out issues pertaining to the public sewer and cut down 2 dangerous trees as you exit the estate onto Langford Street.

4.Cllr M Cahill: That Kerry County Council honour a previous commitment given to me in response to a Notice of Motion I put down in respect of the resurfacing of Annadale Road car park and will the Council give a detailed report in regards to the works involved, the length of time it will take to complete and the total cost of the works, etc.

5.Cllr S Fitzgerald:Will Kerry County council carry out drainage works and install a water channel at Kilcummin, Castlegregory?.

6. Cllr S Fitzgerald:Will Kerry County Council clean the water channel and remove the gravel at Baile an Rannaigh, Baile and Fheirtearaigh?.

7. Cllr S Fitzgerald:Can Kerry County Council serve a Derelict sites notice on the owners of the Ryan's Daughter School House at Dún Chaoin, Co Chiarraí.?

8.Cllr S Fitzgerald:Will Kerry County Council remove the bend and improve the site distance length at Ballydubh, An Clochán.?

9.Cllr S Fitzgerald: Will Kerry County Council remove the bend and improve the site distance length at Baile an Loisce, Baile na nGall.?

10.Cllr S Fitzgerald: What steps are Kerry County Council taking to liaise with the relevant Government Department to identify and make available funding for the completion of the third phase of the Dingle Inner Relief Road. ?

11.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please arrange for a white line & Cats eyes where needed on parts of the R569 road from Kilgarvan to Loo Bridge.

12.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council apply for funding to extend the footpath from the Railway Road Kenmare to Kilmurry, Kenmare.

13.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please fix the wall on the Mangerton road, Kilgarvan, near the junction with the R569.

14.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please undertake an audit on Health & Safety grounds of the trees on the boundaries of Dromnevene Estate, Kenmare.

15.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council request that the gravel is moved in the Laune River, Killorglin near Laune Bridge so as to improve the flow of the river and the river banks could be used better.

3. Erecting more signage warning of children and other pedestrians on the road,

17.Cllr P Connor-Scarteen: That Kerry County Council please resurface the road at Graigue na Greine and Bealdarrig, Blackwater

18.Cllr D McCarthy: To ask Kerry County Council for an update on pedestrian crossing at Kenmare Courthouse to the Finnihy Bridge.

19.Cllr D McCarthy:To ask Kerry County Council when will traffic calming measures be put in place at Glengarriff Road, Kenmare as there have been a large number of crashes in the area.

20.Cllr D McCarthy:.To ask what is the position with allocation of funds for improvement on the Sneem to Kenmare Road.

21.Cllr M O' Shea: To ask the Director of Roads and Transport would they assist Castlegregory Community Council with erecting old place names in the Maharees Peninsula. These old place names will be of a stone structure in specified locations around the Maharees Peninsula.

22.Cllr M O' Shea:To ask the Director of Roads and Transport to extend the footpath within the village of Ballyferriter that ends at the stop sign and to extend this footpath for 300meters to the slip road that leads to the Beach.

23.Cllr M O' Shea:To ask the Director of Roads and Transport to apply to the TII for improvements to the entrance road on the N70 between Astellas Factory and the roundabout on Laune Bridge.

24.Cllr M O' Shea:To ask the Director of Roads and Transport to investigate the flooding problem that is continuously affecting the property owner (Details with Directorate).

25.Cllr M O' Shea:To ask the Director of Roads and Transport to put in place proper signage and road markings at Gormans cross Groyne Killorglin.

33.Cllr N Moriarty:To have a sign erected at the junction of the Glenmore/Lake road and the main N70 road at Ballybrack Waterville stating that the road is a Cul de sac after 8 miles.

43.Cllr J Healy-Rae:That Kerry County Council would place a %Stop Sign+at Kilmurry Estate, Kenmare.

44.Cllr J Healy-Rae:That Kerry County Council would carry out drainage works on the Coast road Tuosist, as it gets extremely badly flooded.

45.Cllr J Healy-Rae:That Kerry County Council would provide three signs on each entrance road to Tuosist saying %Tuosist+.

Following the removal of dentist from the Caherciveen clinic there has built up a serious backlog which means children who are meant to be seen in second class are not being seen until sixth class and in some cases they are in first year of secondary school.

8.Cllr J F Flynn: That South and west Kerry be the first Municipal District next year to have their budget meeting.

9.Cllr J F Flynn: That we write to the minister highlighting the issue of land owners not co- operating with the council in situations where land would be needed to help with site views.

10.Cllr J F Flynn: When is the bus time table going to be erected in Castlemaine by Bus Eireann.

11.Cllr J F Flynn: That we invite the providers of broadband in the South and West Kerry to one of our meetings so we can highlight the poor quality that is been provided.
