KE 051-002

Remains of stone foundations (an archaeological complex), located adjacent to the village.

KE 051-00201

Remains of stone foundations of a possible castle site, located adjacent to the village.

KE 051-00202

Remains of stone foundations of a possible church site, located adjacent to the village.

KE 051-00203

Unmarked graveyard known as "The Children's Burial Ground", located adjacent to the village.

KE-51-003

Remains of stone foundations of circular hut, located within to the village.

KE 051-004

Remains of foundations of a possible holy well, located adjacent to the village.

KE 051-00401

possible cross-inscribed stone, located adjacent to the village. (Cross inscribed stone is not located)

KE 051-005

Circular stone foundations of a fort known as the Doon, located on the Western side of the island.

KE 051-006, KE 051-007, KE 051-008, KE 051-009

Remains of stone foundations of circular huts, located on the southwestern side of the island.

KE 051-012, KE 051-013, KE 051-014

House, located within the village.
