Detached seven-bay single- and two-storey rock-hewn sandstone-built Gothic Revival-style Catholic Church, built 1887-1891, on a cruciform plan comprising seven-bay double-height nave with paired lancet-arch window openings to clere-storey, five-bay single-storey lean-to aisles to east and to west elevations, single-bay double-height transepts to east and to west having four-lancet-light window openings and single-bay single-storey gabled projecting porches to south elevations, five-light window opening to north gable end with single-bay single-storey lean-to sacristy projection and chapel to north-east and to north-west and entrance bay to south gable end having single-bay single-storey gabled advanced porch to ground floor with lancet-arch reveal to paired door openings, paired lancet-arch window opening over, rose window to gable and single-bay three-stage engaged truncated corner tower to south-east on a square plan; extended, c. 1975, with single-bay single-storey flat-roofed projecting chapels added to east and to west elevations. Gateway, c. 1890, to south comprising pair of limestone ashlar piers with lancet-arch door opening to centre having gable over and cast-iron gates and railings.

End-of-terrace four-bay two-storey over basement former warehouse with dormer attic, c. 1870, originally three-bay on a corner site with three-bay two-storey side elevation to west and three-bay three-storey rubble stone-built rear elevation to east retaining early fenestration; extensively renovated and extended to north, c. 1985, comprising single-bay two-storey flat-roofed bay; renovated and refenestrated, c. 1990, with timber pilaster shopfronts inserted to ground floor of both elevations having fluted pilasters and moulded cornices. Pair of freestanding iron petrol pumps, c. 1950, to west; now disused.
