COMHAIRLE CONTAE CHIARRAÍ KERRY COUNTY COUNCIL

Acht Corr-Thrádála 1995 Casual Trading Act 1995

1. Tá cumhacht ag an Údarás Áitiúil limistéar corr- thrádála a roghnú. Aon áit ina bhfuil limistéar corr-thrádála, is cion é corr-thrádál a dhéanamh in aon áit eile i limistéar an Údaráis Áitiúil.
Local Authorities are empowered by the Act to designate casual trading areas and, where casual trading areas are designated, it is an offence to engage in casual trading anywhere else in the local authority area.
2. Beidh ar aon duine go dteastaíonn uathu corr-thrádál a dhéanamh i limistéar corr-thrádála ceadúnas a bheith acu ón Údarás Áitiúil. Beidh ceadúnas ar leith riachtanach do gach limistéar corr-thrádála, agus má theastaíonn ó dhuine trádál i níos mó ná bá amháin sa limistéar céanna beidh ceadúnas breise uaidh.
Any person who wishes to trade in a casual trading area must hold a licence issued by the local authority. A separate licence will be needed for each casual trading area and if a person wants to trade at more than one place in the same casual trading area he will need a separate licence for each place.
3. Tá táille €126.97 ar Ceadúnas Corr-Thrádála. Ina theannta san tá táille €63.49 sa bhliain. (Nó pé costas atá leagtha amach ag an gComhairle) le h-íoc go Comhairle Contae Chiarraí i dtaobh úsáid an bá. Beidh ar na táillí seo a bheith íoctha sara dtabharfar an ceadúnas amach.
The fee for a casual trading licence is €126.97. In addition, a charge of €63.49 per annum (or such other amount as the Council may from time to time determine) is payable to Kerry County Council in respect of the use of the trading bay for which a licence is granted. Both fees must be paid before the casual trading licence will be issued.
4. Tá ceadúnas corr-thrádála do-aistrithe.
A casual trading licence is not transferable.
5. Ní mór iarratas a dhéanamh ar ceadúnas corr-thrádála 30 lá roimh tosú ar chorr-thrádál.
An application for a casual trading licence must be made at least 30 days before the first day on which it is intended to engage in the casual trading to which the application relates.
6. Má tá coinníollacha leagtha amach ag an Údarás Áitiúil beidh siad sa ceadúnas corr-thrádála.
A casual trading licence shall contain such conditions (if any) as the local authority concerned determines and specifies in the licence.
7. Beidh ar aon duine a bhfuil ceadúnas corr-thrádála acu cloí leis na coinníollacha ag baint leis an ceadúnas.
A person who holds a casual trading licence must comply with all the conditions attached to the licence.

8. Is féidir leis an Údarás Áitiúil ceadúnas a dhiúltú nó ceadúnas a chur ar cheal má dhéanann duine cion áirithe bainteach le corr-thrádail.
A local authority may refuse to grant or may revoke a casual trading licence if a person commits certain offences relating to casual trading.
9. Tosóidh ceadúnas corr-thrádála ón data ar an gceadúnas agus fanfaidh sé i bhfeidhm don tréimhse ar an gceadúnas, (múna chuirfear ar cheal é) gan dul thar dhá mhí déag.
A casual trading licence shall come into effect on the date specified in the licence and, if not previously revoked, will remain in force for the period specified in the licence being not more than twelve months and will then expire.
10. Beidh ar aon duine a dheineann iarratas ar ceadúnas corr-thrádála pé eolas a lorgófar uatha ón gComhairle, faoi cumhachtaí atá acu faoi an Acht, a thabhairt. Muna dtugtar an t-eolas is amhlaidh nach mbeidh Comhairle Contae Chiarraí i ndán an ceadúnas a thabhairt do/dí.
A person who applies to a local authority for the grant of a casual trading licence must furnish to the authority such information as the authority may request for the purpose of the exercise of its powers and functions under the act and if the person fails to do so, the authority may refuse to grant the licence to him/her.
11. Beidh ar duine atá i mbun corr-thrádail i limistéar corr-thrádála uimhir an cheadúnais a thaispeáint ionas go mbeidh sé le feiscint go soiléir.
A person engaging in casual trading in a casual trading area must display the casual trading licence number relating to the trading in such a position at the place where he is carrying on the trading as to be clearly visible and easily legible to members of the public at the place.
12. Beidh ar duine atá i mbun corr-thrádail a cheadúnas a thaispeáint don Garda Síochána nó d'aon duine údairithe ag Comhairle Contae Chiarraí má iarrtar orthu.
A person engaged in casual trading shall, on demand, produce for inspection of any person authorised by Kerry County Council, or the Garda Síochána, his Casual Trading Licence.
13. Beidh ar duine atá i mbun corr-thrádail, an Comhairle a shlánú in aghaidh aon éilimh.
A person engaged in casual trading shall indemnify the County Council in respect of all claims howsoever arising from their casual trading.
14. Níl cead ach uachtar reoite agus sólaistí simplí a dhíol ins na limistéir trádála i gcarr-chlósanna i mBaile Uí Thaidhg agus sa Bheannach.
With regard to the designated areas at the Car Parks at Ballyheigue and Banna only trading in Ice Cream and light refreshments shall be permitted.

15. Seol iarratais ar cheadúnais corr-thrádála i limistéar ainmnithe ag Comhairle Contae Chiarraí do chorr-thrádáil ag:-

Reachtaíonn Mír 4 (11) don Acht Corr- Thrádála, 1995, go ndéanfaidh an tÚdarás Áitiúil atá i gceist, teagmháil leis an Aire Sóisialaigh maidir le ainm agus seoladh an té a fuair ceadúnas corr-thrádála agus na coinníollacha a ghabhann leis.

Reachtaíonn Mír 4 (2A) don Acht Corr-Thrádála 1995 (ionsáite ag Mír 141 don Acht Airgeadais, 1996 (uimh. 9 do 1996)) go gcuirfidh an tÚdarás áitiúil na Coimisinéirí Ioncam ar an eolas maidir le ainm, seoladh agus uimhir tagartha cánach don té a fuair ceadúnas corr- thrádála agus na coinníollacha ag gabháil leis.

Reachtaíonn Mír 13 don Acht Corr-Thrádála 1995 go féidir le Údarás Áitiúil clár do na Ceadúnas Corr-Thrádála a bhunú agus a chothabháil ar ríomhaire. Ins an chas san, beidh aon sonraí pearsanta sa chlár faoi réir na riachtanais An tAcht um Chosaint Sonraí, 1988 (uimh. 25 do 1988) ag tógaint san áireamh cearta an duine maidir le teacht ar agus fíorú sonraí faoi mar is cuí.

***Information Note**

Section 4(11) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, provides that the Local Authority concerned shall notify the Minister for Social Welfare of the name and address of a person to whom a casual trading licence is granted and the conditions of the licence.

Section 4(2A) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995 (inserted by section 141 of the Finance Act, 1996 (No. 9 of 1996)) provides that the local authority concerned shall notify the Revenue Commissioners of the name, address and tax reference number of a person to whom a casual trading licence was granted and the conditions of the licence.

Section 13 of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, also provides that a Local Authority may establish and maintain the Register of Casual Trading Licences on computer. In such circumstances, personal data kept in the register is subject to the requirements of the Data Protection Act, 1988 (No. 25 of 1988) including an individual's right of access to and verification of data, where appropriate.
