Structures

Works on the Structures are well underway at the moment and the two main Bridges on the project are nearing completion.

The Overbridge north of the Pound Road (L-2017) is due for completion in advance of Christmas (weather permitting) and much progress has been made on this particular Section of the job since the Precast Beams were placed in mid October, as seen to the left.

The main Structure over the River Maine is also nearing its completion.

At the moment road and accommodation underpasses are well underway.

Road Works

The vast majority of the Earthmoving is now complete.

The recent weather has meant operations have to be scaled back until the start of the New Year.

The Tralee Road Roundabout is almost fully complete, as seen below, and the Farranfore Road Roundabout is due to be operational before Christmas.
