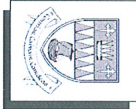

FORM OF NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION 51 (AS AMENDED BY SECTION 9 OF THE ROADS ACT 2007) IN RELATION TO AN APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED ROAD DEVELOPMENT AND THE SUBMISSION OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT AND NATURA IMPACT STATEMENT

N69 LISTOWEL BYPASS PROPOSED ROAD DEVELOPMENT

Kerry County Council has applied under section 51 of the Roads Acts 1993-2015 to An Bord Pleanála ('the Board') for approval in relation to a proposed road development consisting of:

A 5.95km western and northern bypass of Listowel Town Centre of approximately 3.65km of Type 1 Single Carriageway new road and 2.30km of Urban All Purpose Single Carriageway on-line improvement linking the N69 Tralee - Limerick Road North and South of Listowel Town Centre via the R553 Ballybunnion Road and all ancillary and consequential works, as illustrated on the map below and has submitted to the Board the Environmental Impact Statement prepared in accordance with Section 50 of the Roads Acts 1993-2015 in respect of the proposed road development.

A Natura Impact Statement has also been prepared and submitted in respect of the proposed development under Part XA8 of the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2016 for the purposes of Article 6 of the Habitats Directive.

The Board may, in relation to an application for approval by order, approve the proposed road development or any part thereof with or without modifications and/or conditions or any part thereof or it may refuse such development or any part thereof.

A Compulsory Purchase Order has been made in respect of the proposed Road Development.

A person may question the validity of any decision by An Bord Pleanála on a proposed road development by way of an application for judicial review, under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts as provided for in Section 50 of the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2016. 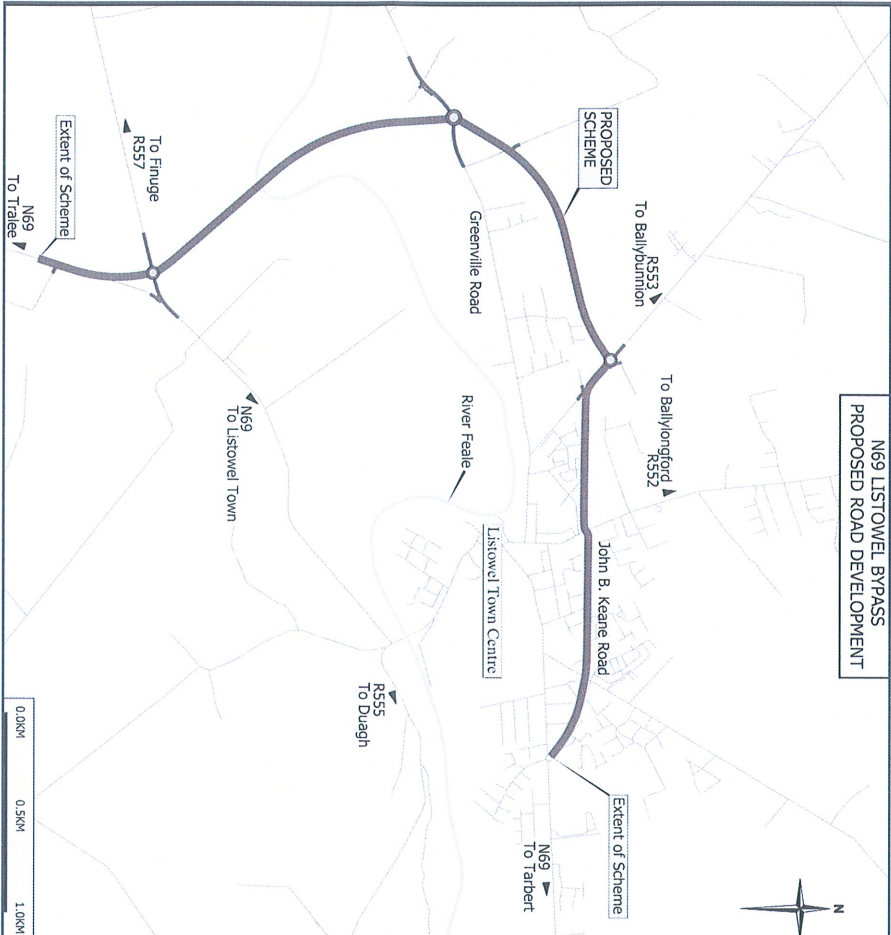
- the likely effects on the environment of the proposed road development;
- the implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development in the area in which it is proposed to situate the development; and
- the likely significant effects of the proposed development on any European Site,

between Monday 15th May 2017 and Friday 7th July 2017, both dates inclusive and a €50.00 fee must accompany any submissions, subject to exemptions in certain cases such as Prescribed Bodies and landowners and others with a legal interest in a compulsory acquisition case.
