Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 38 (3) of the Road Traffic Act 1994, as amended by the Public Transportation Regulation Act, 2009 (Section 46), Kerry County Council **proposes** to install enhanced Pedestrian Facilities at the following locations:

- **L3009 at Gneevgullia National School**
- **L3904 at Countess Road, Killarney**

The proposed works will comprise of the following:

#### **L3009 at Gneevgullia National School**

A Pedestrian Crossing including:

- Signage, road markings and Flashing Amber Beacons
- Red Tactile Paving
- Urbis Lighting
- Build out on the Car Park side of the road
- All associated ancillary and accommodation works

#### **L3904 at Countess Road, Killarney**

- Flat Top Ramp at the location of the existing Pedestrian Crossing
- All associated ancillary and accommodation works
