Re: Proposed Burial Ground Development at Ventry, Co. Kerry

I refer to your Memo dated 2nd April 2013 in relation to the above proposed project.

The proposed development is classified as a sub-threshold development per Schedule 5 of the Local Government (Planning & Development) Regulations 2001.

Having reviewed the documentation provided, including the EIA Screening Report and the HDA Screening Report, the characteristics of the proposed development are considered unlikely to have significant effects on the environment and no potentially significant impacts are envisaged from the characteristics of the proposed development.

It is my opinion therefore that under Article 120(1) to (7) and the criteria set out in Schedule 7 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001, the above proposal does not require the preparation of an EIS.

I confirm that the development is a class of development prescribed for the purposes of Section 179 of the Planning & Development Act 2000 and must comply with the requirements in respect of specified developments by a Local Authority under Part 8 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001. The Part 8 process should address any issues raised in the reports attached.
