The proposed burial ground extension is in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the county and complies with Objective INF 8-61 of the County Development Plan (2009-2015).

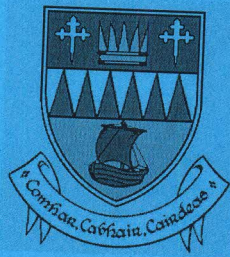
Having reviewed the documentation provided, including the EIA Screening Report and the HDA Screening Report, the characteristics of the proposed development are considered unlikely to have significant effects on the environment and no potentially significant impacts are envisaged from the characteristics of the proposed development.

It is my opinion therefore that under Article 120(1) to (7) and the criteria set out in Schedule 7 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001-2013, the above proposal does not require the preparation of an EIS.
