2. Cllr. N. Kelleher: When will works on the Cultural Centre start and when is the expected completion date?

(b) Notices of Motion

1. Cllr. B. O'Connell: That Kerry County Council install covert cameras at Toreengarrive / Knocknabowl to combat illegal dumping.

2. Cllr. J.J. Culloty: To call on this Council to place receptacles for rubbish and dog foul bags, on the walking / cycling path between the entrances to the Cahernane and Lake Hotels.

3. Cllr. M. Healy-Rae: To ask Kerry County Council to address the previously reported dumping taking place in Coolick near property of (details with Directorate) and ask Kerry County Council to erect illegal dumping signs and cameras as this can't be tolerated.

4. Cllr. D. Grady: Over five years ago a survey was carried out on behalf of Killarney Town Council which indicated that 13% of houses in Killarney were unable to account for disposing of their domestic refuse. I have no doubt that this figure has soared since then. I am proposing that we re-visit this immediately and take the appropriate action. Dumping can be seen in every by-road in our MD area at present.

1. Cllr. D. Grady: What action if any has our Municipal District taken regarding the elimination of plastics? If not, why not?

1. Cllr. D. Grady: That Killarney Municipal District would provide half the Pretty Polly Site for the provision of social housing.

1. Cllr. N. Kelleher: When will the Part 8 for the development of houses on Rock Road be published?

5. (a) To note update report from the Operations, Safety & Infrastructure Directorate

(b) Notices of Motion

1. Cllr. M. Healy-Rae: To ask Kerry County Council what will be done regarding the very dangerous bend at Knockaderry where there have been numerous accidents, adjacent to Skahies Cross.

2. Cllr. M. Gleeson: That the Council would surface dress the road from Gortahoosh Bridge [L.7067-25] to the N22 as it is in a very poor state.

3. Cllr. M. Gleeson: That the Council would make financial provision for the relief of flooding on the L.7047 in 2019.

4. Cllr. M. Gleeson: As the correspondence from Inland Fisheries Ireland [Correspondence Municipal meeting 1st May] might offer some hope of a resolution to the impasse regarding the ever-growing build-up of material on the approach to the Kingsbridge on the River Deenagh - a build-up that threatens the bridge, that may cause flooding up stream and that could possibly compromise the foundation of the great Saint Mary's Cathedral - I

call on the Council to request immediate dialogue with the IFI and the NPWS.

5. Cllr. M. Gleeson: That the Council would, as a matter of urgency, improve the public lighting on the entrance road to Cahernane Meadows, Muckcross Road.

6. Cllr. J.J. Culloty: To ask this Council to engage with the residents of Woodford Manor Estate who are seeking to have traffic calming measures put in place, such as speed ramps and signage, to help reduce the speed of motorists entering and exiting this estate.

7. Cllr. J.J. Culloty: As very few people living a short distance from Killarney cycle to and from town, I call on this Council to set up a Committee to look at meaningful measures which would encourage more people to take up cycling.

8. Cllr. J.J. Culloty: To ask this Council to fit Digital Speed Indicators on the approach roads to Farranfore, from both Currow and Firies roads.

9. Cllr. B. Cronin: To request the provision and erection of signs indicating "Residents Parking only" at Park View Estate, Farranfore as people who are not residents of the area are leaving vehicles parked in the estate while they are away on trips from Kerry Airport.

10. Cllr. B. Cronin: To request the Roads Department to examine improving safety and advance warning signs and lining on the approaches to the Two Mile Community National School.

11. Cllr. B. Cronin: Can a centre white line be put on the road from the Germans Flats Junction through the bad bends towards Aghadoe.

12. Cllr. B. Cronin: Will the appraisal application for Listry Bridge along with up-to-date traffic count be lodged by mid-July.

13. Cllr. J. Sheahan: To place additional street light on Muckcross Road at entrance to Cahernane Meadows.

14. Cllr. J. Sheahan: To provide a footpath on the right hand side along the entrance road to the Ballydribbeen Estate.

15. Cllr. J. Sheahan: To install a raised pedestrian crossing at the eastern side of the Cleeny Roundabout.

16. Cllr. J. Sheahan: To provide additional funding to resurface an additional section of the L7055 (Rathmore Townland) that has deteriorated rapidly and is currently a health & safety issue as the lags are so dangerous.

17. Cllr. M. Healy-Rae: To ask Kerry County Council to consider for inclusion in the next roads programme, the Lisheen Road, Gneeveguilla as it is in a dreadful state.

18. Cllr. M. Healy-Rae: To ask Kerry County Council what progress is being made regarding the installation of turning lanes for residents leaving the N23 onto the Camp Road.

19. Cllr. D. Grady: That we Killarney Municipal District would amend our Bye-Laws to ban deliveries in Killarney Town after 11.00am and make these loading bays parking spaces thereafter (with the exception of New Street Car Park). Also that an investigation would be carried out to identify if this was already included in Killarney Town Council Bye-Laws as it is my understanding that this was already approved by Killarney Town Council in the past.

20. Cllr. N. Kelleher: When will the report commissioned by the TII be available regards the proposed solutions for the major flooding of the N22? Has the second application been made to the OPW for the trees be cut along the river bank.

21. Cllr. N. Kelleher: Can provision be made for residents parking at Church Place in Rathmore and when will the lighting be installed at the pedestrian crossing.

22. Cllr. N. Kelleher: When will the Bye-Laws for busking be introduced in Killarney?

(c) Questions

1. Cllr. M. Gleeson: Has the Council / TII any definite timeframe for the upgrading of the surface of the roundabout at the junction of the N22 and the Park Road / Upper Park Road as its condition is very unacceptable?

2. Cllr. M. Gleeson: Has the Council made any progress towards acquiring the land necessary for the development of an urgently needed footpath from Páirc Chuimín to Kilcummin Village?

3. Cllr. M. Gleeson: Has there been any progress towards the development of a designated parking area close to the Church and Funeral Home in Gneeveguilla?

4. Cllr. J.J. Culloty: What was the overall cost of the CPO for Knockeenduff graveyard land?

5. Cllr. J.J. Culloty: When will new parking meters be installed in Killarney town?

6. Cllr. J.J. Culloty: As the proposed Macroom / Ballyvourney By-pass is of such strategic importance from both tourism and commercial development in the Killarney Municipal District, I am requesting the latest update on same.

7. Cllr. J.J. Culloty: Can Kerry County Council cut back overgrowth around all signage and at junctions within the Killarney Municipal District.

8. Cllr. B. Cronin: When will the new public cemetery at Knockeenduff be open for burials?

9. Cllr. B. Cronin: To ask for a progress report regarding the placement and design of the monument commemorating the 1954 World Ploughing held in Killarney.

10. Cllr. B. Cronin: To request that the Ballytrasna Road, Faha be included in the next Roads Restoration Programme.

11. Cllr. B. Cronin: What is the update with regard to the provision of a footpath from the junction with the N22 to Whitebridge Manor?

12. Cllr. J. Sheahan: If a date when resurfacing of the Kilcummin junction on the N22 Tralee - Killarney road is due to commence.

13. Cllr. J. Sheahan: When will the traffic calming measures be implemented from the Bridge Bar to Rathbeg, Rathmore GAA field and from Rathmore Town also. Residents living along the route are concerned.

14. Cllr. J. Sheahan: To provide CCTV at Ballydribbeen Estate to eradicate dumping in the area and in the river.

15. Cllr. J. Sheahan: To ask Kerry County Council to provide a cycle lane from Ballydribbeen to Killarney Town via Rock Road.

16. Cllr. M. Healy-Rae: To ask Kerry County Council what can be done to improve sight distance at Laharn Cross on the N23, particularly coming from Currans side as this is worryingly dangerous.

17. Cllr. M. Healy-Rae: To ask Kerry County Council to carry out works between Laharn Cross and Cleannclagh Cross as the two strips of tar are coming apart and potholes have formed as a result.

18. Cllr. M. Healy-Rae: To ask Kerry County Council to carry out maintenance works on the Raavaun Road, Farranfore. Potholes need to be filled and dykes cleared. Can this road be considered for inclusion on the programme?

19. Cllr. D. Grady: Do we have a CCTV camera on Monsignor O'Flaherty statue on Mission Road for security purposes? If not, why not?

20. Cllr. D. Grady: When is it proposed to upgrade Well Lane South as it is in a dreadful condition?

21. Cllr. D. Grady: When are the Council putting yellow boxes at (i) Lidl and (ii) the Allman's Terrace side of the Reeks?

22. Cllr. N. Kelleher: Can Kerry County Council ensure that notices be sent to landowners with dangerous trees overhanging our public roadways in the town of Killarney.
