#### ORDÚ LUASTEORANN OIBREACHA BÓTHAIR/ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER

#### An tAcht um Thrácht ar Bhóithre 2004/Road Traffic Act, 2004

In accordance with Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, notice is hereby given that a Road Works Speed Limit Order has been made on a section of the N71 National Secondary Road between Kenmare and Moll's Gap, in the interests of road safety, in order to facilitate pavement overlay works in connection with the N71 Kenmare to Moll's Gap Pavement Improvement Scheme, thereby providing safer conditions for road users and construction workers.

#### **The Road Works Speed Limit to be applied is 60 km/h.**

The speed limit will apply for the period from Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and will remain in place until Thursday, 8<sup>th</sup> July 2021 (both dates inclusive).

The temporary Speed Limit signs are to be erected on a section of the N71 National Secondary Road between Kenmare and Moll's Gap, for approximately 3,000m in length, in a north westerly direction from the existing 60/100km/h speed limit in the townland of Gortamullin and the existing 80km/h speed limit in the townland of Carhoomeengar.
