It is noted that the proposal for Ballyheigue therefore falls within the exclusion outlined in class 10 (k) ie the <i>reconstruction of such works</i>.</p> <p>Therefore, it can be concluded that the proposed reconstruction of coastal protection works along 30m of the L1033 located in the townland of Ballyheigue, Ballyheigue Co Kerry, falls outside the scope of Schedule 5 of the PDRs.
