#### R556 Ballinclogher to Rathscannel Road Improvement Project – Deposition of Inert Material

Public Notice in Compliance with Part XI of the Planning & Development Acts, 2000-2020 as set down in Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001-2020.

Pursuant to the requirements of the above, Notice is hereby given that Kerry County Council proposes to carry out the development, particulars of which are set out hereunder.

#### Suíomh/Baile fearainn nó seoladh poist don bhforbairt atá molta Location/Townland or Postal Address of the Proposed Development

**Location:** R556 Ballinclogher to Rathscannel, Co. Kerry

**Townland(s):** Ballinclogher, Ballyhenry, Derryvrin, Ballysheen, Liscullane, Aghacoora, Gortadrislig and Rathscannel

#### Sonraí faoin Obair atá molta Nature and extent of the Proposed Works

The proposed works will consist of:

- Secure the boundaries of the lands to be contoured
- Strip the topsoil from the area (excluding lands within the buffer zones referred to below) and store in windrow stockpiles away from the works area and any watercourse/ field drain
- Build required haul roads to and through the recontouring area
- Import the deposition materials to the area from the road works by dump truck. The material will be spread and levelled by dozer. Only Article 27 approved materials will be imported to the deposition site
- A 5m buffer zone will be in place from the River Brick system and a 2m buffer zone from all active land drains. No recontouring works will be undertaken within the buffer zone
- Once the final contoured levels are achieved on the lands, the stockpiled topsoil will be spread over the lands and seeded with fast growing seed mix
- Typical level changes on the land will range from 0.0m to 1.5m
- All works fencing, haul roads will be removed, and the lands reinstated
- The lands will revert to the control of the landowner

Kerry County Council as the Competent Authority has concluded that the proposed project, individually, and in combination with other plans and projects, is not one which requires an Appropriate Assessment (AA) or an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and is not likely to have significant effects on the environment.

Pursuant to Article 120(3)(b) a member of the public, may at any time before the expiration of 4 weeks beginning on the date of the publication of this notice, seek an EIA screening determination from An Bord Pleanála as to whether the proposed development would have significant effects on the environment.
