3. **Cllr. R. Beasley:** That Kerry County Council arrange to have the railing at Gale Bridge on the Listowel to Ballybunion Road painted. It has looked very neglected for many years.

Beasley:** That Kerry County Council carry out repairs on the road outside the entrance to the Weigh Bridge at **[Details with Directorate]** which is in a very bad condition and there is a water pipe which supplies a long area almost exposed, it would cause major problems in the area, if broken.
5. **Cllr. R. Beasley:** That Kerry County Council examine the amount of traffic going through Causeway Village with a view to make alterations to slow the speed down.
6. **Cllr. R. Beasley:** That Kerry County Council carry out repairs on all the Secondary roads in the Listowel Municipal District Area as they are in a terrible state due to the lack of maintenance money at the end of 2019.
7. **Cllr. M. Foley:** That Kerry County Council would advise on the up to date position on resurfacing of the L1010-6 from Tarbert Village to the entrance of the Landbank.
8. **Cllr. M. Foley:** That Kerry County Council would repair the dangerous pot hole on the L1006-22 near Corridan's cross.
9. **Cllr. M. Foley:** That Kerry County Council would carry out urgent repairs on the L10467-0 at Kilfeighny South.

21. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** That the missing section of footpath from Causeway Village to Farran Hill be included in the Footpath Programme.
