1. Cllr. T. Barry: When can we expect the advertising in relation to the "See Something Say Something" text alert system put in place at locations in Listowel Town and in other locations in the District.

2. Cllr. M. Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council install high-speed EV charging point in every village and town in the Listowel Municipal District.

3. Planning, Environment and Emergency Management Directorate

1. Cllr. J. Moloney: . What is the up to date position on the taking in charge of The Paddock and Meadows? Also, the safety issues with the private road being used by the residents needs to be addressed.

(b) Notices of Motion

1. Cllr. T. Barry: That the shrubs located in the centre of the Tim Kennelly roundabout at Cahirdown, Listowel be reduced as they are restricting the view of motorists on approach. Also, that going forward, every effort will be made to ensure any future roundabout will not be of similar height in construction.

2. Cllr. T. Barry: That permanent speed signs will be installed coming off the new Ballybunion road roundabout in Listowel. These signs need to be installed before the approach to the Curragh Close Housing Estate on the Ballybunion road, as residents of the estate are extremely concerned that an accident may occur while exiting the estate.

3. Cllr. T. Barry: That road safety measures will be put in place on the approach to the Amber filling station on the N69 Listowel to Tarbert road. Can a 'No Overtaking' sign be placed on both approaches to the station as this would make motorists aware of the potential dangers ahead. There have been a number of accidents on this location to date.

4. Cllr. T. Barry: That repairs will be carried out on the L6064 road at Ballymacjordan, Duagh.

5. Cllr. M. Foley: That Kerry County Council would carry out road realignment on the L1010 at Kilpadogue Tarbert to improve traffic sight lines for residents exiting their properties onto the road. *(Details with Directorate)*

6. Cllr. M. Foley: That this MD would carry out emergency works to protect the L10023, Doncaha, Tarbert, as when the stream running parallel to the road floods it is eroding the road. Also, a barrier is required in the interest of vehicle safety.

6. Cllr. M. Foley: That this MD would carry out works on the brick footpath outside *(Details with Directorate)*, which has sunk and is holding surface water

7. Cllr. M. Foley: That this MD would replace the existing dog waste litter bin on the N67 at the ferry side of St Patrick Terrace. Also, that the MD would provide extra bins on the route to the Ferry Terminal and ensure they are emptied regular.

8. Cllr. M. Foley: That this MD would top dress a section of the surface on the new pier at Tarbert Island Ferry Terminal and repair the dangerous sink hole on the pier.

9. Cllr. R. Beasley: That Kerry County Council take immediate action to improve the road at Clandrief Causeway where there is water coming onto the road.

10. Cllr. R. Beasley: That the fencing be secured outside the home of *(Details with Directorate)*.

11. Cllr. R. Beasley: That Kerry County Council ensures that both beaches in Ballybunion be machine cleaned for the remainder of the summer.

12. Cllr. R. Beasley: That Kerry County Council review the situation outside Scoil de Mhuire de Lourdes in Lixnaw where some safety measures are required to be put in place for the safety of the large amount of children attending the school.

13. Cllr. R. Beasley: That Kerry County Council sort out the problem in relation to *(Details with Directorate)* where the fire hydrant outside their boundary wall floods their lawn when opened.

14. Cllr. R. Beasley: That Kerry County Council spruce up the white lines in the Abbeydorney village and road markings which are very faded

15. Cllr. J. Moloney: There are reports of knotweed along the road in Dromclough. Is there any scheme available to remove it?

16. Cllr. J. Moloney: With the imminent opening of the bypass what measures will be taken to reduce speed in Greenville.

17. Cllr. J. Moloney: Can speed reduction measures be introduced in Kilflynn between the school and the local business nearby.

18. Cllr. J. Moloney: Are there any plans for improving the surface of R551 between Asdee and Ballybunion

19. Cllr. J. Moloney: Can directional road markings be put in place at the junction of Charles Street and Courthouse Road post roadworks.

20. Cllr. M. Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council give an update on the Health & Safety Audit and drainage audit to be addressed prior to the opening of the Listowel Bypass.

21. Cllr. M. Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council give assurances that the works on the closed Foildarrig road at the Kilmorna bridge is a short-term measure as a bigger priority project is needed to keep this bridge open to the public.

22. Cllr. M. Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council, as a matter of urgency, contact the Office of Public Works to lower the depth of the dyke, leading from the newly constructed bypass, to reduce the threat of flooding at 2 locations in Greenville, Listowel.

23. Cllr. M. Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council confirm has funding been secured from TII for the N69 into Listowel from Bolton's Cross to the Tim Kennelly roundabout.

24. Cllr. M. Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council confirm the current stance in relation to the 2024 general maintenance budget for road repairs (potholes) and if any available surplus budget has been provided to the Council.

25. Cllr. A. Thornton: Please provide an update in relation to Safety Works Scheme for Abbeydorney Village.

26. Cllr. A. Thornton: Please provide an update in relation to longer term works for Foildarrig Bridge along with an update in relation to works completed.

27. Cllr. A. Thornton: Please provide an update in relation to the Drainage Plan for Listowel.

28. Cllr. A. Thornton: Can the Members be updated on the Failte Ireland funded toilets and changing facilities for Ballybunion.

3. **Cllr. T. Barry:** Can a section of the footpath outside the home of *(Details with Directorate)*, be lowered to accommodate a wheelchair user at this location.
4. **Cllr. T. Barry:** Can Members get an update on any progress made in relation to the ongoing issues for residents of the estates in the Castleinch area of Listowel town.
5. **Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would scour the drains outside *(Details with Directorate)*, as surface water is eroding the entrance of the property owner.
6. **Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would pipe the water course on the L6003 to Hannons Strand, Beale, Asdee, outside *(Details with Directorate)* in the interest of safety.
7. **Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would erect Speed Limit signs on either side of the L1031 at Ladies Walk Ballyduff.
8. **Cllr. M. Foley:** That his MD would repair the concrete channels outside *(Details with the Directorate)* on the L1025-73.
9. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** Can the fence at the Grotto in Derrendadif be repaired?
10. **Cllr. J. Moloney:** Is there any opening date for the bypass?

11. Cllr. M. Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council proceed with the proposed Bus Eireann bus-stop and shelter at the Tanavalla Industrial Estate, with the imminent opening of the Listowel Bypass.

12. Cllr. M. Kennelly: Can Kerry County Council give an update on the proposed safety and road improvement works into Moyvane village, with a timeframe for completion.

13. Cllr. A. Thornton: Can Kerry County Council confirm if the independent Safety Audit and Drainage Audits have been completed re the bypass.

3. Cllr. A. Thornton: Can the Members agree to write to Minister Kieran O'Donnell to organise an interagency meeting with Uisce Éireann, the OPW and Kerry County Council in relation to the Drainage Plan for Listowel and Flood Relief Scheme for Listowel.
