1. Cathaoirleach's Report on the Budget CPG Meeting held on 24 September 2024.
2. To consider the Local Authority Budget for the Local Financial Year ending 31 December 2025, prepared by the Chief Executive in accordance with Section 102 of the Local Government Act 2001, as amended.

3. To adopt, with or without amendment, the Local Authority Budget for the Local Financial Year ending 31 December 2025, subject to the provisions of Section 103 of the Local Government Act 2001, as amended.

That Kerry County Council makes a scheme for the abatement of rates due to it by liable persons, or classes of liable persons, in respect of vacant properties in accordance with the provisions of Section 9 of the Local Government Rates and Other Matters Act 2019, as amended. Such a scheme in respect of Vacant Property will provide for a 100% abatement of rates due to Kerry County Council by a liable person as provided for in Section 9 (1) of the Local Government Rates and Other Matters Act of 2019 for the financial year ending 31st of December 2025.
