##### **(b) Notices of Motion**

**1. Cllr. T. Barry:** That repairs will be carried out to L6023 Road at Leitrim East Moyvane.

**2. Cllr. T. Barry:** That this Authority will contact the office of the Minister of Transport and request that funding will be provided for the maintenance of our public car parks.

**3. Cllr. T. Barry:** That repairs will be carried out to the road surface at courthouse lawn in Listowel Town.

**4. Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would carry out urgent repairs on the footpath at Bridewell St, Tarbert, from ***[Details with Directorate]***.

**5. Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would carry out measures to prevent surface water entering a property on the Glin Rd, Moyvane, ***[Details with Directorate]***.

**6. Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would strongly consider introducing ramps through our villages to control traffic speed.

**7. Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would carry out urgent repairs on the footpath at Well St, Ballylongford, outside ***[Details with Directorate]*** as it is a possible trip hazard.

**8. Cllr. M. Leane:** That traffic calming measures be put in place, such as speed ramps, along Harty's Terrace, Ballyheigue / Mountway Road L-6089-0. Residents there requesting same as there has been an increase in traffic along this road and there is a lot of children and elderly people living in the area.

**9. Cllr. M. Leane:** Can the fencing on Dolly's Green, Ballyheigue, including the fence along the cliff edge, be replaced for safety reasons as it was damaged by Storm Eowyn and it has been decaying over the years?

**10. Cllr. M. Leane:** That a handrail be installed at the end of Ballyheigue promenade for the slope down onto the beach.

**11. Cllr. M. Leane:** That the KCC yard in Causeway be cleaned up as it is overgrown, litter is being dumped there, and it is attracting rodents.

**12. Cllr. M. Leane:** The fence between Kilcaragh Estate and Kilcaragh Lawn, Lixnaw, was damaged and has collapsed. It has now become an unofficial pedestrian pathway. Can the fence be repaired as a matter of priority?

**13. Cllr. L. Nolan:** Can the road heading to Derryco Graveyard, Ballyduff, be resurfaced with tar and chip?

**14. Cllr. L. Nolan:** Drainage works were carried out outside the chemist in Lixnaw Village. The water is still causing damage at the footpath side of the road leading to the water being splashed onto the walls and footpath. Could this be examined?

**15. Cllr. L. Nolan:** Can the platform outside Flanagan's Bar, Church Street, Listowel, be removed, as it is no longer in use?

**16. Cllr. L. Nolan:** The trees at the bottom of Woodgrove Estate, Moyvane, need to be cut back. In stormy weather they are becoming a concern for the residents.

**17. Cllr. J. Moloney:** What is the status of the design/funding for the N69 Cahirdown to Boltons Cross?

**18. Cllr. J. Moloney:** Has there been any information on the safety report and solutions on the Listowel bypass?

**19. Cllr. J. Moloney:** Can the build out on Lower Church Street be removed?

**3. Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would repair the undulation on the L6013-26 at Derra, Asdee.

**4. Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would repair the footpath on Glin Road, Moyvane, outside *[Details with Directorate]* on the L1015-26.

**5. Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would carry out repairs on the R551-298 at Ballyconry outside *[Details with Directorate]* to prevent serious ponding outside the properties.

**6. Cllr. M. Foley:** That this MD would give an update on the Bus stop for Ballybunion.

**7. Cllr. T. Barry:** Can repairs be carried out to the road surface on the laneway at the rear of *[Details with Directorate]* Listowel.
