Certain requirements will apply to the Community Involvement Scheme

- 1. The Council will assess the condition of the road under consideration using the Paving Rating Manual (rating range is 1 to 10 with 1 being very poor and 10 being excellent).
- 2. The Council will record the road length, width and the number of dwellings along the roads under consideration.
- 3. The Council will estimate the overall cost of each scheme taking account of material, labour, machinery and traffic management costs. The community contribution may in each case be in money or in kind (labour/machinery) or both. This will then determine the percentage contribution.
- 4. Taking into account the findings of points 1-3 above, the Council will then prioritise the roads for funding.

The Scheme is limited to the most cost effective proposals submitted (subject to funding being made available)
