Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, and the Temporary Closing of Roads Regulations 1994, Kerry County Council **has decided** to close to public traffic the following streets:

Island of Geese (L-6728-0)
Waterloo Lane (L-6728-1)
Bridge Lane (L-10928-0)
Gas Terrace (L-10929)
New Road (R-551-673)
Staughtons Row (R-551-673)
Rock Street (R-551-673)
Bill Booleys Lane

Street Closing Times: from 08.00 a.m. on Monday, 20th October 2025 to 08.00 am on Monday 19th October 2026, both dates inclusive.

The purpose of the road closure is to facilitate the 'Tralee Pavements Phase III' project. This project involves the upgrading of Rock Street, New Road, Gas Terrace, Island of Geese Road, Bridge Lane and Bill Booley Lane by the provision of a "shared space" consisting of a level surface between the footway and the carriageway and enabling pedestrians to move freely while reducing the priority of vehicles.

Construction works will be phased over the 18-month anticipated project period. Depending on the work location there will be scope for opening of partial sections of the above listed roads which will allow for limited access for public traffic during work periods to minimize impact to businesses and the Bridge Lane Taxi rank.

Traffic diversions will be in place. Provision will be made for Taxis to continue to operate from Bridge Lane Rank for as long as possible. Alternative arrangements will be made for Taxis

during works on Bridge Lane. Provision will be made for loading on New Road via Lower Rock Street and Stoughton's Row.

There will always be south bound traffic on Rock Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Access will be provided for emergency services.
