SECTION 75 OF ROADS ACT 1993**

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, and the Temporary Closing of Roads Regulations 1994, Kerry County Council is **proposing** to close to public traffic the following roads:

Road Closed: Church Street (N70) - commencing at the Junction of the N70 (outside the Carnegie Building) and Bridge Street to the junction of the N70 and O'Connell's Street, Cahersiveen

Road Closing Times: From 7.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight on Friday, 31st July, Saturday, 1st August, and Sunday, 2nd August 2026.

The purpose of this road closure is to facilitate the holding of the 2026 Cahersiveen Music and Arts Festival.

Road Closed: From Banks Corner (L-4005-26) to behind the existing Library (L-11903), Cahersiveen

Road Closing Times: From 9.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 29th July to 12.00 noon on Tuesday, 4th August 2026
To facilitate the holding of a Fun Fair.

A traffic diversion system will operate on the main approaches to the town.

Diversions at the top and bottom of O'Connell Street and Bridge Street for traffic travelling through the town and onwards towards Killorglin and Waterville.

Local access will be provided for emergency services and local residents.

Any person having an objection to the above proposal should lodge same, in writing, marked **Road Closure**, with the Administrative Officer, Roads Maintenance & Operational Services, County Buildings, Tralee, County Kerry or by e-mail to roads@kerrycoco.ie not later than **4.00 p.m. on Monday, 13th July 2026.**
