Market Street, Lower Bridge Street from Bianconi Inn to the Square (Traffic Island)

From 6.00 a.m. on August 11th - 1.00 a.m. on August 12th, 2026
From 6.00 a.m. on August 12th - 1.00 a.m. on August 13th, 2026
Upper Bridge Street, The Square (To Macks Corner), Lower Bridge Street, (To Bianconi Inn), Market Street
From 6.00 a.m. on August 10th - 1.00 a.m. on August 11th, 2026
From 6.00 a.m. on August 12th - 1.00 a.m. on August 13th, 2026
Langford Street from (Macks Corner to the entrance to the Paddocks)
From 6.00 p.m. on August 9th - 1.00 a.m. on August 13th, 2026
The Mill Car Park
From 9.00 p.m. on August 7th – 9.00 p.m. on August 12th, 2026
Junction Railway Road / Aldi Underground Carpark to Junction Railway Road / School Road (the road that links Iveragh Road to School Road).

A traffic diversion system will operate on the main approaches to the town.
